

Mary Ann Gruber

Mary Ann Gruber was born November 10, 1941, in St. Paul, Minnesota. She was an only child, spending her early childhood in the Como Park area, while her father worked for Honeywell during The War. The family moved to the "new development" of St. Louis Park, where Mary Ann attended grade school at Lennox Elementary, and then 3rd grade-8th grade at Holy Family Catholic School, under the same Nun for all those years! Rounding out her high school tenure at Holy Angels in Richfield, Minnesota, she was active in the AVOC Club, college prep courses, and volunteering with her local chapter of the CYC (Catholic Youth Club).

Next for Mary Ann was St. Scholastica, in Duluth MN, pursuing a Medical Records Degree. Well, love came calling and a move back home after 2 years of school ended her educational pursuits, and she soon found herself getting married to George Gruber, to whom Mary Ann was married for over 50 years. They lived in an apartment on Como Avenue (back to her roots!) for the first three months of their marriage, and eventually bought a house in Maplewood, Minnesota. They had two children (Bernard John & Theresa Claire), and George's affiliation with the Minnesota National Guard brought him into active service and he was stationed in Vietnam for the early stages of the war. Mary Ann took care of the house & kids, and to

make ends meet, was prompted to get involved in Minnesota Transport Services Association (MTSA), where she worked for 35 years - beginning as Secretary and winding up as CEO & President of the Association. During George's service years and their children's high school years, Mary Ann traveled to Europe & beyond, chasing down family connections from ages past.

Mary Ann has fought back from 2 strokes, and has been a Cardigan Resident member since 2019, keeping strong involvement in our Book Club, Card Club, YMCA Exercise Classes, Bus Outings, and plenty of walks around the back pond. She's also on our Resident Gardening Committee, and nurtures & maintains our gorgeous plants and flowers on the grounds. She enjoys the people here at Cardigan Ridge, laughing with one another, and getting to know new residents, as well. She signs all her cards to children, friends, and family, "Love 'n' Prayers." This valediction is extended to her Cardigan Ridge family, as well, she says.




