Congratulations to November and December's Employees of the Month! Our picks for these months are two extremely dedicated team players that always get the job done!



#### CALLBOX AVIAILABLE FOR USE

The Callbox at the Front Entrance is once again available for use. This will make it easier for Guests to access the building after business hours and on weekends.

#### **HOW TO USE:**

- 1) Guests will use the **arrow keys** to search for a resident's name (All names will be in alphabetical order).
- 2) Once a resident is selected, guests will press the "CALL" button on the keypad.



- The resident will then receive a call to the personal phone number provided to Cardigan Ridge.
- 4) Residents should answer the call, then press "9" on their phone. This will open the Front Door, allowing the guest entrance to the building.
